Dear Parents,

Wow! What a wonderful first day of school. As I walked through the halls and visited the classrooms, I witnessed the teachers fulfilling our mission to *“provide our students with an academically challenging Classical Liberal Arts education that helps them develop a passion for learning.”* The students came ready to learn, with smiles on their faces.

Please remember that our school hours have changed to **7:45 A.M. to 3:15 P.M.**

For clarification purposes, I would like to reiterate a couple of the dress code policies.

1. Kindergarten through 4<sup>th</sup> grade wear plain white tennis shoes all day, which includes P.E. class. They **do not** dress out for P.E.
2. Fifth grade – **does not** dress out for P.E., but may bring any closed tennis shoes to wear during P.E. They wear black dress shoes in either loafer or lace-up style.
3. Sixth grade through 8<sup>th</sup> grade **do** dress out for P.E. wearing any closed tennis shoes for P.E. They wear black dress shoes in either loafer or lace-up style for the rest of the day. The clothing for P.E. is a black or navy P.E. short, which must be knee length, and a white t-shirt or spirit shirt.
4. The only approved classroom cover-up is a French Toast navy v-neck cardigan button up sweater for boys, and a French Toast navy crew neck or v-neck cardigan button up sweater for girls. Fleece cover-ups are **no longer** an approved classroom cover-up. If you have not yet ordered your child’s sweater, please see our website for ordering information.

Thank you for your attention to these details; when you send your student to school in the appropriate dress code it enables us to use our time for education.

Your support and collaboration has been evident by your attendance at the orientations and back to school night. We appreciate the unity of our community!
